Thus water, with small mixtures of glutinous or carbonic substances, produces, on the application of heat, spirits and gases. Corn, or grains of wheat laid on a tablet of glass, covered with a layer of straw only, may be made to grow on the application of heat and water. This experiment, performed on a large scale for a number of years, would cause the produce, from its own decay yearly, to form soil, on which plants would grow.
