

Thus certain body cells acquire a new function, i. e., making a new zymogen, activated by the foreign protein. The protein of the first injection is slowly digested without recognizable effects, and we conclude that the animal has not been affected in any way. The foreign protein has been digested, but this has been done so slowly and gradually that we have not been able to observe the effects. After this protein of the first injection has been disposed of, the new ferment in the form of a zymogen continues to be formed in the cells, and on the second injection, after a proper interval, this zymogen is activated and splits up the protein so promptly and so abundantly that the liberated protein poison induces the symptoms of anaphylactic shock. This action is specific and the proteolytic ferment acts upon that protein, which brings it into existence and no other. In some cases this development...
